Due to the COVID-19 virus outbreak & subsequent the measures taken by the concerned authority, the 10<sup>th</sup> examination results will be expected in later June 2020. NMIMS has decided to provide admission of the above said program on the basis of candidate's 9<sup>th</sup> Examination total Science & Mathematics marks (refer the instruction handout).

The candidates are requested to input their 9<sup>th</sup> examination marks in place of 10<sup>th</sup> examination by **30<sup>th</sup> April, 2020**. The admission will be granted on merit and on **PROVISIONAL** basis. The candidate needs to fulfil the eligibility criteria mentioned in instruction hand-out after the 10<sup>th</sup> examination result is declared.

If the candidate is ineligible based on the 10<sup>th</sup> examination result, the provisional admission will be forfeited and fees will be refunded as per the refund- rules mentioned in the instruction handout.

**Refund Rules:** The Schedule of refund of fees will be as follows as per UGC rule Oct 2018:

If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution concerned shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

| Sr. No. | Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees* | Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to HEI   |
|---------|---|---|
| (1)     | <b>100%</b>                             | 15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission (on or before 7 <sup>th</sup> July 2020)  |
| (2)     | <b>90%</b>                              | Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission. (i.e. from 8 <sup>th</sup> July 2020 to 23 <sup>rd</sup> July 2020)                |
| (3)     | <b>80%</b>                              | 15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission (i.e. from 24 <sup>th</sup> July 2020 to 7 <sup>th</sup> August 2020)                  |
| (4)     | <b>50%</b>                              | 30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission (i.e. 8 <sup>th</sup> August 2020 to 22 <sup>nd</sup> August 2020) |
| (5)     | <b>00%</b>                              | More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission (i.e. from 23 <sup>rd</sup> August 2020 onwards)   |

In case of (1) in the table above, the deduction will be 5% of the fees paid as processing charges from the refundable amount, subject to a maximum of Rs 5,000/-.

Note: The above refund rules are subject to revision as per UGC notification (as applicable).
