Due to the COVID-19 virus outbreak & subsequent the measures taken by the concerned authority, the 10th examination results will be expected in later June 2020. NMIMS has decided to provide admission of the above said program on the basis of candidate's 9th Examination total Science & Mathematics marks (refer the instruction handout).

The candidates are requested to input their 9th examination marks in place of 10th examination by **5th June 2020 (for Phase-3 only)**. The admission will be granted on merit and on **PROVISIONAL** basis. The candidate needs to fulfil the eligibility criteria mentioned in instruction hand-out after the 10th examination result is declared.

If the candidate is ineligible based on the 10th examination result, the provisional admission will be forfeited and fees will be refunded as per the refund- rules mentioned in the instruction handout.

Refund Rules: The Schedule of refund of fees will be as follows as per UGC rule Oct 2018:

If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution concerned shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to HEI
(1)	100%	15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission (on or before 1st July 2020)
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission. (i.e. from 2nd July 2020 to 17th July 2020)
(3)	80%	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission (i.e from 18th July 2020 to 1st August 2020)
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission (i.e 2nd August 2020 to 16th August 2020)
(5)	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission (i.e from 17th August 2020 onwards)

In case of (1) in the table above, the deduction will be 5% of the fees paid as processing charges from the refundable amount, subject to a maximum of Rs 5,000/-.

Note: The above refund rules are subject to revision as per UGC notification (as applicable).
