1. **Program** : B.Tech (for Mumbai Campus only)

Stream: Mechanical, and Computer.

**Stream Specializations (Opted from 4th year)**

- **Mechanical Engineering (60 Seats)**

Specializations: Design & Manufacturing, Automation and Artificial Intelligence

- **Computer Engineering (180 Seats)**

Specializations: Artificial Intelligence, System Security

2. **Eligibility criteria**

“The Candidate must have passed the SSC (Std X) examination or its equivalent, by securing 70% of aggregate marks in subjects General Sciences and Mathematics OR Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics”

**2.1 For Maharashtra State Board Candidates: -**

- I. Candidates who have passed Maths / Mathematics (Code 71 for Maharashtra State Board Candidates) and Science & Technology (Code 72 for Maharashtra State Board candidates) are only eligible for admission.

**2.2 For CBSE / ICSE / IGCSE Candidates: -**

- I. General Science / Physics & Chemistry with Mathematics subjects' marks shall be considered in aggregate marks.
- II. Other vocational subjects / combination will not be considered in aggregate.

**Note:**

- Only single marksheet with all compulsory subjects taken and passed in first attempt is mandatory, no compartmentalized marksheet will be considered.
- Those candidates who have passed, or, are appearing for 10<sup>th</sup> examination from a Board / University where Grade Point Average is given, such candidates must produce in writing from the Board / University concerned, the equivalent percentage for the GPA obtained.
- Candidate above 20 years of age are **NOT ELIGIBLE** to apply (applicable for all boards).
- Candidates passing 10<sup>th</sup> or equivalent examination from Open or Distance learning (ODL) school recognized only by National Institute of Open schooling (NIOS) can apply for the program subject to fulfilling the eligibility of the program.
- Candidate whose final mark sheet is not available at the time of admission are required to submit final copy of result duly attested by Principal of the school / college before the course commencement date, failing which candidate will not be admitted.
- Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their 10<sup>th</sup> or equivalent examination from overseas board / Universities.
- All admission will be completed on provisional basis, subject to the fulfillment of eligibility criteria mentioned in the point no. 2 and the decision of the institute will be final in this regard.
- Candidates appearing for their final 10<sup>th</sup> or equivalent examination can also apply provided they should fulfill / meet minimum cut off marks and should be eligible & produce all the necessary documents in original at the time of admission.
- It is sole responsibility of the candidate to ascertain whether they possess necessary and requisite qualification for admission to courses at NMIMS.

**4. Admission Process:****4.1 Online Registration & Payment of Registration Fee**

- Visit [www.btinmims.edu](http://www.btinmims.edu) for online registration.
- Online Registration Fee of Rs. 1,000/- plus GST if applicable (Please refer online registration for payment details)
- Registration Fee is **NON-REFUNDABLE**.

#### 4.2 Selection Process:

- Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the performance of the candidate in 9<sup>th</sup> or equivalent exam aggregate marks (including Semester 1 & Semester 2, aggregate marks wherever is applicable)  
AND the preferences mentioned in the registration form.
- Candidate can check their Merit result on the NMIMS website as per important dates.
- If the candidate has entered wrong marks in online registration form, then the candidate will be disqualified for further admission process. In any stage if it is found that, the 9<sup>th</sup> / 10<sup>th</sup> examination marks given by candidate in application form is different from marks actually obtained (as per marksheet) such candidate's admission will be cancelled and fees will be forfeited.
- The decision of the institute will be final in this regard and no inquiries or correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

#### Note:

- Candidates are required to update 9<sup>th</sup> or equivalent examination aggregate marks along with Maths, Science and English marks in online registration form. **Candidate will not be considered for merit list if they fail to update the same in online registration form or their result is not available during this period.**
- **The Candidates who have passed 9<sup>th</sup> Examination, the aggregate / total marks shall be total marks of all subjects taken into consideration and mentioned on the marksheet of both semesters where it is applicable.**
- Student seeking admission on the basis of Group 1 & Group 2 subjects only, the **aggregate marks** shall be the grand total of marks in all subjects from Group 1 & Group 2 where he/she has scored maximum marks.
- Student seeking admission on the basis of Group 1, Group 2 & Group 3, **aggregate marks** shall be the grand total of all subjects from all groups.

- At any given point of time it is found that the information given by candidate i.e. 9<sup>th</sup> or 10<sup>th</sup> exam Score is incorrect, the candidate admission will be cancelled and fees will be forfeited. Therefore, its sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure that correct marks are entered.

## 5 **Program Fees**

Fees for Batch 2020-21 was Rs. 2,02,000/- p.a. (for information only).

Fees for the current year will be intimated at the time of admission.

## 6 **Refund Rules:** The Schedule of refund of fees will be as follows as per UGC rule Oct 2018:

If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution concerned shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to HEI
(1)	<b>100%</b>	15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission
(2)	<b>90%</b>	Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission.
(3)	<b>80%</b>	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission
(4)	<b>50%</b>	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission
(5)	<b>00%</b>	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission

In case of (1) in the table above, the deduction will be 5% of the fees paid as processing charges from the refundable amount, subject to a maximum of Rs 5,000/-.

Note: The above refund rules are subject to revision as per UGC notification (as applicable).

## 7 **Important Instructions**

- Candidates will be offered Programme based on the availability of seat, candidates merit rank, choice.
- Candidates are requested to select the preference carefully while registration. Same would be considered for merit process. Preference/s once selected, cannot be changed at any reason.*

- Please see the important dates and preserve it as a guide. All announcements from the University will be through its website [www.nmims.edu](http://www.nmims.edu) and there will be no separate mail sent. **Kindly check website regularly for any updates.**
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to check whether he/she is eligible for the program as per the eligibility criteria stated above.
- Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidate.
- Candidate's documents will be verified at the time of admission (if selected) & if found not eligible admission will be cancelled and fees will be forfeited.
- If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/her is incorrect, then the application for the admission to the Program, even if selected and fees paid, will stand cancelled and fees will be forfeited.
