VT collaboration

- M. Tech. Data Science – 3 courses of the 10 delivered by VT faculty coming down to Mumbai
- From this year collaboration for three programs
 - B. Tech. AI
 - B. Tech. CS (Cyber Security)
 - B. Tech. Data Science

7 courses delivered by VT, curriculum development, quality control ...

What is it ?

The 311 coordinated program

- B. Tech. CS (Data Science program) – the “3 ” part at NMIMS
- BS Cybersecurity Management and Analytics –(CMA) the “1” part- BIT Dept. - Pamplin School of Business- VT
- MS Business Administration- Specialization -Business Analytics – BIT Dept. Pamplin – VT “1” part

Coordinated delivery of the “311” programs in 5 years

The “3” Part of the “311”

- Students will be enrolled for the B. Tech. CS (specialization Data Science) program which is of 4 years duration
- The first “3” years will be at MPSTME, NMIMS Mumbai
- The program aims to cover all requirements for the B. Tech.
- The fourth year will be spent at VT – credits for courses taken at VT will be transferred for the B. Tech. Program.
- The curriculum is structured appropriately to also facilitate transition and enrolment for BS Cybersecurity and Analytics

The first “1” part of “311”

- Students will move to North Virginia Campus – Innovation campus of Virginia Tech. where the first “1” i.e. the fourth year of the coordinated program will be conducted
- Before proceeding to VT
 - students would have completed about 20 credits in Liberal arts and Gen. education
 - these courses will be completed in the three years spent at NMIMS along with the B. Tech. program
- Complete the course work for the first “1” part at VT and become eligible to earn **BS Cybersecurity Management & Analytics which is a STEM program**

The **second** “1” part of the “3**1**1” initiative

- Having Completed the **first** “1” of the “3**1**1” and met requirements of MS program
- Enroll for the **second** “1” of the “3**1**1” initiative in the fifth year
- The fifth year of the initiative will enable a student to earn a
 - MS in Business Administration - specialization - Business Analytics
 - receive both BS and MS degrees at the end of the fifth year
 - engage in OPT for 3 years as per present norms
- Both the programs i.e. BS & MS will be conducted at the “Innovation Campus” of VT at North Virginia near DC area which is near the Amazon HQ2 facility
- Tuition fees for the BS & MS programs will be out of state tuition fees

What is the “311” initiative advantage ?

- A coordinated initiative by two top ranking universities
- Opportunity for earning 3 degrees – B. Tech., BS , MS
- Right blend of technology (cybersecurity & data science, applied statistics, business analytics)
- BS & MS programs at “Innovation Campus” of VT in North Virginia – near Amazon HQ2, opportunity to pursue live projects, beyond classrooms learning – internships, vibrant and conducive ambience for innovation and startup culture
- STEM program giving an opportunity to pursue OPT for 3 years

What is the “311” Advantage ?

- Curriculum co-designed by VT & NMIMS
- Best practices of both NMIMS & VT to be utilized in the initiative
- Student ready for global engagement and exposure
- Cost likely to come down to 50 % of the cost compared to 5 years study in US

- Smooth hassle free transition from UG to PG
- Exposure to best practices of two highly ranked universities
- Study at a location where innovation will thrive along with cross cultural experience
- At a much reduced cost

Eligibility and Admission criteria for the “311” program

- **Limited** seats for the program
- Students are being **admitted** through
 - NPAT 2020 based on merit – Online, remote proctored exam.
 - valid SAT score (Aug 2018 onwards)
 - valid ACT score
- **Eligibility** based – PCM min. 50 % , ICSE/ IB equivalent

How do I enrol for this program ?

- While opting for this program you may indicate preference in the dropdown at “B. Tech. Computer Science (Data Science)”
- Even if you have not opted earlier, the option is open to you
- **When you come for on line counselling opt for “B. Tech. Computer Science (Data Science)” which will be leading to enrolment for this Coordinated program**

When will Engg. programs start ?

- From 10th August Online Orientation
- Later Online engagement
- Face to face -around Middle of September or even later - only when we are sure that you and we will be safe
- Presently NMIMS authorities engaged in intense preparations to ensure that the campus is ready for face to face delivery

- *Once confirmed it cannot be changed*
- *The confirmation letter and fees notice will be mailed to the registered email id*
- *Upgradation can be requested with the faculty*

- *The Fees have to be paid within 48 hours to confirm the seat*
