1. Program: MCA

This Handout gives information about the admission procedure and admission test for two year MCA for the academic year 2020-2021.

2. Eligibility Criteria:

Bachelor degree with **minimum 50% aggregate marks** in Arts, Science, Commerce, Management or any other discipline.

Note:

- Candidates appearing for final year can also apply.
- Candidates who have cleared their graduation by doing a part-time course or through distance learning, correspondence courses, externally, open school from recognized University are eligible to apply & register as per UGC guidelines.
- Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their Under-Graduation from overseas board/ Universities.
- 3. Duration: 2 Years
- 4. Intake: 60

5.2 Payment of registration fee:

- Register Online on website www.nmims.edu & Pay registration fee of Rs 1,100/- (Non-refundable)
 (Please refer online registration for payment details)
- On the basis of information indicated in the Application Form, call letter for Test & personal interview
 will be communicated to the candidate as per important dates through the NMIMS website.
- Candidates are required to download the call letter from our website www.nmims.edu and upload below mentioned document. No separate call letter will be mailed or posted to the candidates. It is important and primary requirement to upload the mandatory documents before Entrance Test / Personal Interview. The list of mandatory documents is as follows:
 - Degree Marksheet & Certificate (for passed candidate)

- > 10+2 Examination Passed Marksheet and Certificate
- > 10 Examination Passed Marksheet and certificate
- Photo ID proof Aadhaar Card / Passport / Voter ID / Driving License (Learner license will not be accepted)
- Candidate's application form will not be considered, if they fail to upload the above mentioned documents till 11th June, 2020 before 12.00 noon.
- No candidate without call letter will be permitted to appear for the written test & personal interview.

7. Program Fee:

Fees for Batch 2019-20 was Rs. 1,41,500/- p.a. (For information only).

Fees for current year will be intimated at the time of admission.

8. Refund Rules: The Schedule of refund of fees will be as follows as per UGC rule October 2018:

If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution concerned shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to HEI
(1)	100%	15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission (on or before 1st July 2020)
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission. (i.e. from 2 nd July 2020 to 17 th July 2020)
(3)	80%	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission (i.e from 18 th July 2020 to 1 st August 2020)
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission (i.e 2 nd August 2020 to 16 th August 2020)

(5)	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission (i.e from
	33,5	17 th August 2020 onwards)

In case of (1) in the table above, the deduction will be 5% of the fees paid as processing charges from the refundable amount, subject to a maximum of Rs 5,000/-.

Note: The above refund rules are subject to revision as per UGC notification (as applicable).

9. Important Instructions:

- Please see the important dates and preserve it as a guide. All announcements from the University will be through
 its website www.nmims.edu and there will be no separate mail sent. Kindly check website for regular updates.
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to check whether he / she is eligible for the program as per the eligibility criteria stated above.
- Admission for appearing Candidates will be provisional till submission of Final Marksheet and will be confirmed
 on submission & if found eligible as per eligibility criteria.
- Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidate
- Candidates are required for admission process in person.
- Candidate's documents will be verified at the time of admission (if selected) & if found not eligible admission will be cancelled and fees will be forfeited.
- For cancellation/ withdrawal of admission: Withdrawal / cancellation means voluntary withdrawal / cancellation by candidate for any reason. Candidate should email at admissioncancellation@nmims.edu, the soft copy of admission cancellation form duly filled and signed (form available on www.nmims.edu & https://www.nmims.edu/students/, fee paid receipt copy & cancelled cheque (personal account only).
- If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/her is incorrect, then application for the admission to the Program, even if selected and fees paid, will stand cancelled and fees will be forfeited.
- NMIMS has full right to disqualify a candidate at any stage of admission process if found ineligible.
