**1. Introduction:**

Mukesh Patel School of Technology Management and Engineering was established in the year 2006 under the aegis of Narsee Monjee Institute of Management Studies as one of its constituent Schools. All programs of MPSTME are approved by the AICTE. Further, NMIMS deemed-to-be University is accredited by NAAC with 3.59 CGPA and Grade A+ in the 3rd cycle (Mumbai Campus). Additionally, Bachelor of Technology programs of IT and EXTC are accredited by NBA since 2014. This handout gives information about the admission procedure and admission Test / PI for Three Years Full-time for B.Tech. Second year direct admission & Four-year Full Time for MBA Tech Second Year admissions for the academic year 2022-23.

**2. Program:**

**B.Tech. (for vacant seats only)**

➤ **Specialization:**

- **For Mumbai Campus:** Civil Engineering, Computer Engineering, Data Science, Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering, Information Technology, Mechanical Engineering, Mechatronics Engineering, Artificial Intelligence, Computer Science & Engg (Cyber Security).
- **For Shirpur Campus:** Computer Engineering, Computer Science, Information Technology, and Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning.
- **For Navi Mumbai:** Computer Engineering, and Artificial Intelligence & Data Science.
- **For Indore Campus:** Computer Engineering.

**MBA Tech. (for vacant seats only)**

➤ **Specialization:**

- **For Mumbai Campus:** Computer, Data Science, Information Technology, Mechanical, and Artificial Intelligence.
- **For Shirpur Campus:** Computer, and Data Science.
- **For Navi Mumbai & Indore Campus:** Computer.

**Important:**

- **Vacant seats will be calculated after NMIMS student's internal transfer to MBA Tech. and B.Tech. Program.**
- **Further admissions will be done by counseling.**

- Detail schedule will be displayed separately in counselling offer letter.
- Existing NMIMS / MPSTME / STME candidates cannot apply for this process.

### 3. Eligibility Criteria:

#### MBA Tech.

- Candidates passing Diploma with minimum 75% (aggregate score as mentioned in final marksheet) or equivalent at Diploma.
- Candidates passing First Year of B. Tech. / B.E. with CGPA  $\geq$  3.00 out of 4.00 or equivalent marks (aggregate) and no Backlog of First year.

#### B.Tech.

- Candidates passing Diploma with minimum 60% (aggregate score as mentioned in final marksheet)
- Candidates passing First Year of B. Tech. / B.E. with CGPA  $\geq$  3.00 out of 4.00 or equivalent marks (aggregate) and no Backlog of First year.
- **For Second Year MBA Tech / B. Tech. seats, Diploma candidates will be given preference. If any seats remain vacant thereafter candidates passing first year of B.Tech. will be considered.**
- Candidates are required to mention aggregate percentage given in final year marksheet for Diploma candidate & CGPA / aggregate Percentage given in first year mark sheet for First year Engineering candidates in online registration form.
- **Candidate will not be considered for merit list if they fail to mention / update the same in online registration form or their result is not available during this period.**
- Candidates awaiting result are not eligible to apply.
- Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their Under-Graduation from overseas board/ Universities.
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure that correct marks are entered.
- At any given point of time it is found that the information given by candidate i.e. 10<sup>th</sup>, Diploma / First year Degree Exam Score is incorrect, the candidate admission will be cancelled and fees will be forfeited
- Candidate above 25 years of age are not eligible to apply.
- Diploma holder of any stream will be eligible for any stream of Engineering and Technology.

### 3. Admission process :

#### Online Registration & Payment of fees:

- Visit [www.nmims.edu](http://www.nmims.edu) for online registration.
- Online Registration Fee of Rs. 2,000/- plus applicable taxes Registration Fee is **non-refundable / non-transferable**.
- The Candidates may be called for counseling session at Mumbai campus, based on the merit list. Candidates are required for admission process in person for counseling session. Candidates should carry the Demand Draft / Pay order of eligible course fees. The payment details will be mentioned in counseling call letter.

- In the counseling session, candidates will be given admission to various disciplines as per their merit, choice and availability of discipline as per eligibility criteria & vacancy.

4. **Selection Process:**

- Merit list will be prepared based on the performance of candidate in Diploma / 1<sup>st</sup> year engineering examination.
- The decision of the institute will be final in this regard and no inquiries or correspondence in this regard will be entertained

**Merit Tie: Determination of merit in case of Tie:** If two or more candidates secure equal number of marks in Diploma / 1<sup>st</sup> year engineering, their relative merit will be decided based on candidate securing higher aggregate Percentage marks in 10<sup>th</sup> examination.

6. **Refund Rules:** The Schedule of refund of fees will be as follows. If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution concerned shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to HEI
(1)	<b>100%</b>	15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission
(2)	<b>90%</b>	Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission
(3)	<b>80%</b>	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission
(4)	<b>50%</b>	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission
(5)	<b>00%</b>	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission

In case of (1) in the table above, the deduction will be 5% of the fees paid as processing charges from the refundable amount, subject to a maximum of Rs 5,000/-.

Note: The above refund rules are subject to revision (as applicable).

**7. Important Instructions**

- Candidates once admitted in particular program/Specialization/campus will not be upgraded to another program/specialization & Campus
- Please check eligibility criteria before applying for the course.
- Candidates are required for admission process in person.
- Candidate's documents will be verified at the time of admission (if selected) & if found not eligible admission will be cancelled and fees will be forfeited
- For cancellation/ withdrawal of admission: Withdrawal /cancellation means voluntary withdrawal/cancellation by candidate for any reason. Candidate should visit <https://upload.nmims.edu/admission/cancellation/>
- If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/her is incorrect, then application for the admission to the Program, even if selected and fees paid, will stand cancelled and fees will be forfeited.
- NMIMS has full right to disqualify a candidate at any stage of admission process if found ineligible.
- Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidate
- All matters of dispute will be subject to the legal jurisdiction of Mumbai only.
