Dr. Santosh Bothe is a Professor and Head IEDC at SVKM's NMIMS Shirpur.

Prof Santosh is PhD, Post Doc and Visiting Scientist, University of Rome, Italy.

He holds doctorate in Biomedical Engineering and Alternative Medicine and has carried out his post doctoral research at Health Involved Technical Engineering Group jointly at University of Rome and University of Heidelberg.

Prof Santosh is a pioneer in Voice Analytics for Disease Screening and holds patents in this area.

He is a recipient of prestigious Erasmus Mundus fellowship for his doctoral and post-doctoral research at City University London and University of Rome respectively.

In 2014, Prof Santosh was conferred the “Young Scientist 2014” by European Commission out of 42 participant countries for his research on Acoustic Analysis of Speaking Voice for Disease Screening.

His project was carried out at San Giovanni Batista Hospital and San Raffaele Hospital Rome, Italy.

His research interest includes General AI, ICT in Care delivery, Bio-Signal Analytics for Remote Care, Digital Biomarkers for Disease Screening.
