1. **Program:**

**B.Tech.**

➤ **Specialization:**

- **For Mumbai Campus:** Artificial Intelligence, Civil Engineering, Computer Engineering, Computer Science & Business System, Data Science, Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering, Information Technology, Mechanical Engineering, Mechatronics Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering (Cyber Security) & Computer Science & Engineering (Data Science) .
- **For Shirpur Campus:** Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning, Computer Engineering, Computer Science, Information Technology and Computer Science & Engineering (Data Science).
- **For Navi Mumbai Campus:** Artificial Intelligence & Data Science, and Computer Engineering.
- **For Indore Campus:** Artificial Intelligence & Data Science, and Computer Engineering.
- **For Hyderabad Campus:** Computer Engineering, and Computer Science & Engineering (Data Science).
- **For Chandigarh Campus:** Computer Engineering, and Computer Science & Engineering (Data Science).

➤ **Specialization:**

**Note: Non NMIMS-CET candidate will be considered only if vacant seats are available after NMIMS-CET merit listed candidates**

**Eligibility criteria: It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to check his/her eligibility before applying for the course.**

**10+2 Candidate :**

Candidate must have passed 10 + 2 or equivalent examination from a recognized board, including International Baccalaureate Diploma with English as a compulsory subject with science or vocational science,

minimum 45% marks in PCM for all campuses. Those awaiting their 10+2 or equivalent examination result this year may also apply AND candidate with IB Diploma is eligible only if he/she has offered Mathematics.

**Diploma Candidate :**

Candidates Completed Diploma in Engineering with Minimum 45% (aggregate score as mentioned in the final marksheet) is eligible to apply. The candidate will be admitted based on relevant specialization in the Diploma.

**Note: Diploma candidates will be considered for admission after 10+2 candidates.**

- **For MBA Tech / B. Tech. Non-NMIMS CET admission, CUET / JEE Main / MH-CET or any state Govt. CET qualified candidates will be given preference in admission counselling process.**
- Candidates **Diploma awarded** from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board will be considered equivalent to 10+2 examination providing they have confirmed 24 grades/credits compulsory and have passed 3 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL) plus extended essay and Theory of Knowledge (TOK).
- Candidates **Diploma Programme (DP course) awarded** from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board will be considered equivalent to 10 +2 examination with 2 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 2 subjects at Standard Level (SL) OR 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL) and 1 subject at Higher Level (HL)
  - a. **IBCP equivalence for General Strand** (Arts, Commerce, Science, Law): Candidates Career related Programme (CP) course awarded from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board will be considered 2 DP subjects with at least 1 subject at Higher Level (HL) and minimum 3 points in each DP subject. Additionally, it is necessary to complete at least 03 Career Related Studies (CSR) courses given by IB-approved partners, such as the World Academy of Career Program.
  - b. **IBCP equivalence for Engineering or Medicine Strand:** Candidates Career related Programme (CP) course awarded from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board will be considered 3 DP subjects (Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology or other similar subjects) with at least 1 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and minimum 03 points in each DP subject.
- Additionally, it is necessary to complete at least 03 Career Related Studies (CSR) courses given by IB-approved partners, such as the World Academy of Career Program.
- Addition qualifying requirements as specified by statutory agencies such as AICTE and PCI in accordance with program requirements.
- In the online registration or e-admission form (if selected) for the 10+2 or equivalent exam, candidates who have passed through any examining board (such as the State Board, CBSE, ICSE, etc.) should indicate the aggregate scores of all the subjects they have taken, opted for, and for which appeared for (not the best of four, five, six, or seven subjects).
- The aggregate percentage of all subjects the candidate has opted and appeared will be taken into consideration for confirming eligibility of the candidate for the program at the time of admission.
- For A Level Examination (Cambridge Board) with minimum 3 subjects at advance level will be taken into consideration for calculation of aggregate percentage. Ungraded subjects/grades will not be taken into account.
- The candidate shall have passed all the subjects opted and must have appeared in the applicable examination/s in a single attempt.

- Candidate will not be eligible if any subject is marked as ungraded / fail in the mark sheet / grade sheet even if the relevant examining board declares the candidate passed. (except Cambridge Board).
- If the mark sheet issued by any examining board shows scores in percentile(s), a point system, GPA/CGPA, or performance bands, candidates must provide the equivalent aggregate percentage. For IB board students, an official Indian conversion transcript is mandatory. If a Grade Point Average (GPA) or Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) is provided, candidates must submit the certified equivalent percentage. Please note that the actual aggregate percentage of all subjects listed on the official grade sheet will be considered for eligibility
- The mandatory subject must be taken and passed in accordance with program eligibility.
- IB & Cambridge Candidate: Candidates who do not have final mark sheet will be given “Provisional Admission” based on predicted scores. Fees will be accepted from such candidate but their admission will be confirmed on submission of final mark sheet before the commencement of the program, if found eligible. The mark sheet/s / transcript/s issued by Board / University shall only be considered.
- International School candidates and those who have completed their (10+2) or equivalent examination (s) from overseas schools/Institutes/Universities will have to submit an AIU certificate of equivalence (mandatory) to confirm their eligibility for the program as equivalent to the (10+2) examination (s). This criterion also applies to candidates who have completed open school, distance learning, or correspondence courses.
- Only single mark sheet with all compulsory subjects passed is mandatory, no compartmentalized mark sheet will be considered. (Except Cambridge Board)
- A candidate whose final mark sheet is not available at the time of admission is required to upload internet copy / Digi Locker copy of the result within 07 working days of the announcement of the final examination result to confirm the program eligibility. The candidate’s admission will be revoked if they fail to present the mandatory document within the specified timeline.
- Candidates who have cleared their 10 + 2 (12th Standard) by doing a part time course or through distance learning, correspondence course externally, open school from a recognized University are eligible to apply & register as per UGC guidelines.
- If at any stage of the program it is found that a candidate does not meet the eligibility criteria or has furnished incorrect information in the application form, his/her admission to the course, even if already admitted, will stand cancelled. Fees will be refunded as per the applicable refund rule clause. If the candidate does not voluntarily withdraw, the University will proceed with cancellation of admission.
- The admission information handout's eligibility requirements will serve as the only document for program eligibility. School's brochure or prospectus or any other promotional material will only be used as a guide and not be used to refer to eligibility.
- The payment of fees does not confirm fulfilment of the admission eligibility criteria. Admission will be granted only after verification of all required documents and compliance with the prescribed eligibility norms.

- The candidates shall have passed all the subjects taken & appeared for in the applicable examination/s. The aggregate percentage of all subjects for which the candidate has taken & appeared will be taken into consideration & PCM % for confirming eligibility of the candidate for the program.
- In case the mark sheet issued by the applicable Board / Institution is in percentile/s, the actual aggregate percentage of all the subjects appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration.
- Candidate above 25 years of age are not eligible to apply.
- Note (for IB & Cambridge Candidate): Candidates called for admission counseling on the basis of NMIMS merit list & who have not received final marksheet till then will be given Provisional Admission based on predicted score. Fees will be accepted from such candidates but their admission will be confirmed only on submission of final marksheet before the commencement of the program if found eligible.
- Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their 10+2 or equivalent examination from overseas board/ Universities
- Those candidates who have passed, or, are appearing for 10+2 or equivalent examination from a Board / University where Grade Point Average is given, such candidates must produce in writing from the Board / University concerned, the equivalent percentage for the GPA / CGPA obtained.
- Candidate whose final mark sheet is not available at the time of admission are required to submit internet copy / Digi-Locker of result duly attested by Principal of the school / college with official seal, failing which, candidate will not be admitted.
- Only single marksheet with all compulsory subjects taken and passed in one attempt is mandatory, no compartmentalized marksheet will be considered.
- Candidate will not be eligible if any subject is marked as ungraded / fail in the marksheet / grade sheet. For absent / Ungraded in any of the additional / non mandatory subject will be consider as eligible provided such candidates is declared as pass by respective board.
- Candidates appearing for their final 10+2 or equivalent examination can also apply provided they obtain the required minimum cut off marks and also produce all the necessary documents, in original, within the given stipulated time.
- Admission to the program is considered as “**Provisional Admission**” till all required and mandatory documents are submitted by the candidate and the same is verified and approved. If it is found that the candidate is not eligible at any stage (even after the course commencement), admission will be cancelled, and fees will be refunded as per the refund rule clauses, even if selected/admitted to the program.
- The XII (Qualified) examination should have been conducted before the course commencement date.
- Mark sheet / Transcripts issued by the Board / University only will be considered (School / Institute will not be accepted).
- Internal / Stream Transfer will not be entertained.
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ascertain whether they possess the necessary and requisite qualification for admission to courses at NMIMS University.

2. **Duration:** B.Tech. 4-Years & MBA Tech. 5-Years, Full Time.

### 3. **Admission Process:**

➤ **Online registration & Payment of fees:**

Registration online on the website [www.nmims.edu](http://www.nmims.edu) & Pay fees of Rs. 2,000/- plus applicable taxes (if any). (Please refer online registration for payment details.)

➤ **Selection Process:**

- **For 10+2 candidate:** Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the performance of the candidate in Physics, Mathematics and Chemistry or Vocational subject of 10 + 2 or equivalent exam
- **For Diploma candidate:** Merit list will be prepared on the basis of aggregate marks of Diploma exam.
- Candidates will be called for counseling session at Mumbai based on the merit list.
- In the counseling session candidates will be given admission to various disciplines as per their merit, choice and availability of discipline as per eligibility criteria.
- The decision of the institute will be final in this regard and no inquiries or correspondence in this regard will be entertained

**Note:**

- Candidates are required to update 12<sup>th</sup> or equivalent exam / Diploma marks (aggregate score as mentioned in final marksheet) in registration form.
- **Candidate will not be considered for merit list if they fail to update the same in online registration form or their result is not available during this period.**
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure that correct marks are entered.
- At any given point of time if it is found that the information given by candidate i.e 12<sup>th</sup> or equivalent exam / Diploma Score is incorrect, the candidate admission will be cancelled and fees will be forfeited

➤ **Merit Tie: Determination of merit in case of tie.**

If two or more candidates secure equal number of marks in 10 + 2 or equivalent exam / Diploma exam, their relative merit will be decided as per following order:

**For 10+2 Candidate:**

- (a) Candidate securing higher marks in the subject of Physics
- (b) Candidate securing higher marks in the subject of mathematics
- (c) Candidate securing higher marks in the subject of Chemistry / vocational subject

**For Diploma Candidate**

- a) Candidate securing a higher aggregate percentage marks in the 10<sup>th</sup> examination.

4. **Refund Rules:** As per the notification of UGC. Details will be shared at the time of admission.

**Note:**

Please note the closure of admission / last date of admission as mentioned in the important dates of the respective programme.

The Candidate is requested to check the commencement date. The cancellation policy/date is applicable, as mentioned in the admission offer letter.

5. **Program Fees:**

The fees mentioned are for the 2025 batch (last year) and are for reference purposes only.

**Fees for the 2026 batch will be communicated at the time of admission.**
